Matthew 9:35-10:1

- The “my-opia” prayer: “Lord Jesus, as I interact with others today, help me to see them as you do.”

For this coming week:

- With some Christian friends, pray, and go to public places where ordinary people gather. Prayerfully consider what you see and hear. Discuss what you noticed, what you felt, what disturbed you, what you felt God was showing you.
- The next time you are at a restaurant, learn your server’s name. Explain that it is your custom to thank God for every meal. Look the server in the eye, use their name, and ask if there is anything going on in their life that you could pray for. Listen, observe body language, and proceed as the Spirit leads. Leave a generous tip regardless of their response.
- Each morning, pray the “my-opia” prayer above. Keep a journal of things you notice during that day that surprise you. Ask God what he’d like you to do about what you are noticing.
