"If our good deeds create a road for our good news to travel, let's finish the trip." - Doug Pollock, author of God Space

For this coming week:

- How might God be stirring you **to bring the whole gospel to the whole person?**
- Each morning, pray the "my-opia" prayer. Keep a journal of things you notice during that day that surprise you. Ask God what he'd like you to do about what you are noticing. **The "my-opia" prayer: "Lord Jesus, as I interact with others today, help me to see them as you do."**
- Make sandwiches for someone in need. As you deliver them, pray that God will use the simple meal to meet their physical needs and point them to the One who can meet their spiritual needs.
- Consider whether you may practice the spiritual discipline of fasting. (Check with your doctor in case fasting is not a good idea for you.) Presbyterian Book of Confessions: "But let everyone fast to this end, that he may deprive the flesh of its fuel in order that he may the more zealously serve God." [Second Helvetic (Swiss) Confession]
