Life “IC”: _____ .

For this coming week:

- Reflect on your relationship with God through Christ. For what are you yearning?
- Perhaps you desire a relationship with God for the first time? Maybe you wish to deepen your faith or trust God more? What do you need to make this step?
- What was your life like before you knew God and the gospel of grace?
- How is your life changed, and how do you experience “Christ in you”?
- What sin have you been rescued from? What sins or rough spots of your character do you desire help with from the Holy Spirit?
- How is Christ energizing you to work in and through you? Make an “oikos” list: a list of eight to 15 people, people who are in the circles of your life (family, friends, co-workers, neighbors, etc.) - and pray for them DAILY. Pray for them to be reconciled to God and to come to faith in Jesus, or to deepen in their next step of faith. Your part is to pray, and God will do the rest!
