A door of opportunity.

Do we control worship, or ...

Worship of God revives us because:

1. Worship is ...
2. Worship has God ...
3. Worship is our response ...
4. Worship is the way we ...

For this coming week:

- What could be an act of worship for each day of this week that could get you centered, having God as your center?
- Enjoy a conversation with someone about worship this week: When were you inspired and blessed, and why?
- Read and say out loud the Lord’s Prayer, or Psalm 100, or Psalm 150 each day this week.
- Do a “stop-in-your-tracks prayer” this week:
Be still, and know that I am God.
- If you think of it, ask someone how they are doing beneath that mask, and if/how you can be praying for them.
