Apostles' Creed - Part 4 (of 6)

- *“The third day he rose again from the dead,”*
 - ◇ Doctrine of the Resurrection
 - ◆ *Fact or Fiction? Optional or Essential?*
 - ◆ *What does Adam have to do with Jesus’s resurrection?*
- *“He ascended into heaven, and sits on the right hand of God the Father Almighty;”*
 - ◇ Doctrine of the Ascension
 - ◇ Doctrine of Sovereignty and Lordship of Jesus Christ
 - ◆ *Who is really in charge?*
 - ◆ *What happens when you go sailing with Jesus?*
- *“From there he will come to judge the living and the dead.”*
 - ◇ Doctrine of Eschatology
 - ◆ *Not: “Look busy, Jesus is coming back!”*
 - ◆ *What would it be like to not be afraid?*
 - ◆ *The life of surrender*

- Why is the resurrection of Jesus Christ important? ... to you?
- What difference does it make that Christians are an “Easter People”?
- If a non-believing friend asked you to explain the resurrection of Jesus, what would you say?
- Jesus is listening ... What do you need to say to him today in prayer?
