Why begin with saying thanks?

For this coming week:

- Make a blessing list. Take your time.
- Tell at least two people from that list what they mean to you ... thank them.
- Write out 2 Corinthians 4:15-18. What word(s) speak to you?
- On Thanksgiving Day, pause and hold some bread, and think of Jesus who is with you.
- Bring food to our Deacons' Pantry this week.
- Pray for the people within your reach, that Jesus will be in their cup, at their table.
- Listen again, or read the lyrics, to *Now Thank We All Our God*. Send the YouTube to someone you know.
