John’s Prologue: In the beginning...

Dimensions of Darkness

...The Light

For this coming week:

- Notice how sunrise is later and sunset is earlier during Advent. What lights will you put up or put on this season?
- We all struggle and experience darkness in some way. Journal or name ways that you’ve struggled with darkness. How does the Light of Life shine in your life?
- How will you help others this season to experience the Light of Christ?
- Pray regularly for 8-15 people in your reach, who sit on the “front row” of your life ... that they may know and experience the Word ... the Light ... the one true Lord and Savior, Jesus.
