For this coming week:

- Express in art or words what the light of Christ means to you.
- If you took a step of forward faith in Christ, share that with someone you know/trust.
- Do a Christ light bright project this week: speak or show Jesus' love to someone who is struggling or who does not know about Jesus.
 - Ideas: Give to our Advent Gift of the Heart project; call someone who is sick or lonely; drop off food for our Deacons' Pantry; ask someone if you could pray for them; special-gift a good charity; year-end gift our church; tell someone how they reflect God's light to you.
 - Invite folks you know to join us for worship on Christmas eve. Host a worship group for streaming and praise.
- Sing the words of a Christmas carol as an act of praise. After singing, then quietly pray through those same words ...
